

IDET: negotiation place of leading experts

One of the strong sides of this jubilee event - the 10th Exhibition of Defence and Security Technologies – will be its top class concurrent programme. The accompanying events have always been the gems of IDET, and this will be absolutely true also this year. The structure of the international conferences and seminars reflects, among others, the broadening range of the Exhibition, covering the field of safety/security technology with the appropriate services.

New materials, training, dynamic demonstrations and exhibitions

The traditional CATE 2009 Conference (Community – Army – Technology – Environment) that was held during all previous IDET Trade Fairs will provide the backbone of the concurrent events also this year. The University of Defence Brno is the organizer and the guarantor of the CATE 2009 Conference. The whole set of events will comprise, among others, the 10th professional seminar Materials and Technologies for Manufacturing Special Equipment, the International Conference Tactics 2009, an international scientific symposium under the title 9th Symposium on Weapon Systems, an international scientific conference Military Technology, the 11th International ITTE Conference under the title of User Role in the Integrated NEC Environment, the International Conference on Economy, Logistics and Ecology in the Armed Forces, another international scientific conference under the title Security and Protection of Information, the closed conference of PVO radar users under the title NATO RAT 31 Support Conference, or the international conference on the Education of Military Professionals in the Defence and Security Forces.

In the course of all three days an attractive show will be offered at a specially prepared open-air training polygon adjacent to Hall Z, demonstrating wheel vehicles made by national and international manufacturers. Novelties relating to the protection against floods can be found by all concerned at the pond in front of hall Z, many of the exhibits again so-to-say in full action. The Association of Fliers of the Czech Republic prepares an exhibition focusing upon the Foreign Resistance Fight during WW II – The Pilot Legends - that will be hosted by hall G under the tower.

Strong participation of foreign politicians, military chiefs and experts

The Army of the Czech Republic is going to play a double role at IDET 2009. First of all, it will be again the biggest exhibitor of the whole Trade Fair. The halls G1, G2 and the adjacent open air spaces showcasing the exhibits of the Army will display, in addition to the most recent technology, the programme of planned acquisitions. Practically all decision makers in the field of procuring both technology and services for the Czech armed forces will be available here during the three days of the event. Visitors considering possible enlisting in the bodies of the professional army can contact a fully functional recruiting army center opened here during the fair.

On the other hand, the Army of the Czech Republic is also the guarantor of a broad participation of foreign delegations of the ministers of defence or their deputies, the chiefs of general staffs and directors of armament offices of dozens of countries world-wide.



The lady-minister of Defence of the Czech Republic will officially invite the delegations of all NATO states, the countries joined in Partnership for Peace and many others to take part in IDET 2009. Also delegations of the steering and commanding bodies of NATO, the EDA representatives, the ambassadors and air-force attachés in the Czech Republic are expected to come to IDET.

Enhanced role of the security technology and services

IDET reflects the current situation and the trends in the field of defence and security. An expression of such consideration can be seen in the broadening of the range of this exhibition. After the recent enrichment by adding the security technology, the respective services and the protection of persons, there is yet another new field, and namely the fire fighting technology and services that will be accommodated in hall Z. Thus the IDET exhibition becomes the target of a specific group of visitors, namely those from the government administration or self-government. This will complement the vast profile of visitors representing the Czech military forces, the delegations of foreign armies and expert visitors from all over the world. Of course the regular visits of the political representation of the Czech Republic, especially of the members of the Cabinet and of the Parliament of the Czech Republic, should not be left out of consideration.

The last IDET exhibition in 2007 reached 27 564 registered professional visitors having come from 59 countries.

Actually, IDET is the best opportunity to make a presentation in the market covering an extensive part of the NATO countries, with particular focus upon those from the last two extension waves. In this part of the world, namely, IDET is undisputed No 1 among analogous events. Accordingly, the exhibitors need not bother visiting all those countries, quite the other way round, important speakers of the Army and of the respective Ministries of Defence will arrive to meet them themselves.
